PURPOSE:

Notice is hereby given that the Commissioners' Court of Orange County, Texas, will discuss and possibly take action on an abatement agreement with Enterprise Products Operating LLC, the record owner of the subject property and applicant for tax abatement, on Tuesday, October 25th, starting at 2:00pm in the Commissioners' Courtroom of the Orange County Administration Building, 123 S. 6th Street, Orange, Texas. Enterprise Products is considering an estimated \$850,000,000 investment within the Reinvestment Zone #3 located on Old Mansfield Ferry Road along the east bank of the Neches River in the western portion of Orange County, Texas. The proposed project will be an ethane export terminal and will have the capacity to load refined and fully refrigerated ethane at approximately 300,000 barrels per day on ships at the export terminal.
