ORANGE COUNTY CDBG-DR APPLICATION PROJECT SUMMARY DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS

Project Description:

During Tropical Storm Imelda, Kinard Estates in Orange County received over 2 feet of rainfall. The existing drainage facilities quickly filled with silt and sediment, eroded and were unable to adequately direct water away from residences, commercial buildings and infrastructure which led to widespread flooding of streets and overflow of drainage structures, causing environmental hazards and other threats to public health and safety.

The proposed improvements will reduce a risk to public health and safety caused by the damaged drainage ditches.

Construction will consist of the regrading and reshaping of approximately a mile and a half of existing ditches and concrete lining.
